



OFFICIAL 2026 RADIOWORLD EDGE GUIDELINES, RULES & CONDITIONS

Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts dates for the 2026 season are from January 1st, 2026 through December 31st, 2026.

Win(s) shall be defined as "first place."

Only wins of eligible tournaments posted on www.radioworld.ca/edge are eligible for payouts. Contingency paying events may be added or deleted solely by Radioworld Inc. at any time.

Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts contingency paying events must reach the following criteria to be considered for contingency payments: (i) Fifty (50) boats or more; ("Minimum Criteria"). If the contingency paying event does not meet the Minimum Criteria, it shall not be subject to the Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts contingency payment but will be in the form of a Radioworld gift card.

The anglers are responsible for submitting the Tournament Finish Affidavit form timely (*within 14 days*) and completed to Radioworld, Inc.

Angler Eligibility

Any anglers fishing a qualifying tournament who have made an eligible purchase from Radioworld Inc. (defined herein), fish from the registered boat for the duration of the tournament, and are enrolled in the Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts program are eligible for a payout.

You must fish from your registered boat for the full duration of the tournament.

You must display Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts decal on driver's windshield/console of registered boat you are fishing from.

In the event of a team-sanctioned event, only one (1) Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts payment will be paid to the eligible Boater or Team Captain. Co-anglers or non-boaters fishing from a registered boat in a Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts tournament, or if they own an eligible boat, they are not eligible for payout. They must fish from their registered boat and be classified as a single participant in the Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts paying event.

Persons employed by Radioworld Inc., Garmin, Humminbird, Lowrance, Power-Pole, or their affiliated companies are not eligible for Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts payments.

Radioworld Inc. pro-staff who are under contract with Radioworld Inc. are not eligible for the program.

Only sanctioned tournaments listed on www.radioworld.ca/edge prior to tournament date are eligible.

Eligible Radioworld Purchases

Purchase three (3) or more core items with a minimum total value of \$7,500 pretax after January 1st, 2024, from Radioworld to be eligible for the 2026 program. In the event an item purchased is on sale when purchased, the regular price of the item will apply to the \$7,500 qualifying amount.

Qualifying purchases for the Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts program must be made between the dates of January 1st, 2024 through December 31st, 2026.

Eligible core items are defined as below:

Lowrance Transducers – Active Target 1 or 2*

Humminbird MFD – Apex, Xplore*, Helix Multifunction Marine Displays

Humminbird Transducers – Mega Live, Mega Live 2*, Mega 360

Minn Kota Trolling Motors – 24v or larger bow mount motors Ultrex, Ultrex Quest, Terrova, Terrova Quest, Ulterra, Ulterra Quest

Minn Kota Shallow Water Anchors – Raptors or Talons

Power-Pole Shallow Water Anchors – Blade, Blade One-Pump, Sportsmen, Pro-Series II

Power-Pole Trolling Motors – Move ZR and Move PV

Power-Pole Power Management - Charge (CH500)

Lithium Batteries – Dakota, APEX or Relion over 100ah

Other Rules & Regulations

Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts payments will be awarded only to single overall winner of a Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts paying event. Big fish awards, ties, and winners decided by chance are NOT eligible.

Concurrent contingency paying events, where two or more events take place at the same time and allow entrants in each event to use the same fish for both weigh-ins, are NOT eligible.

The reporting and payment of all applicable taxes associated with value/income received under the Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts program, including but not limited to Radioworld Edge Performance Payouts payments, are the sole responsibility of the recipient.

The angler is responsible for providing authentic and official verification of a tournament win and any other rules and condition requirements and guidelines.

Official Tournament Finish Affidavit Forms available online at www.radioworld.ca/edge or by calling 416.667.1000, must be submitted within 14-days of tournament completion for eligibility review and qualification incentive. *(Please allow four to six weeks for approval and processing)* Any submissions received after 14 days will not be eligible.
